NOTES TO THE EXHIBITORS OF OUR BYLAWS AND REGULATIONS

Doors open from 6am with all exhibitors declared on site by 9am. Any competitors travelling from out of county will have the opportunity to travel down the night before.

Exhibitors are responsible for the safety of their stock and equipment at all times.

No exhibitors can leave before all classes have been completed.

NO stock to leave designated compound during the show.

All passports must accompany **ALL** animals; handing in on arrival.

All competitors to wear white coats.

The committee reserve the right to limit the number of calves entered per exhibitor should the numbers exceed capacity.

There will be **NO** straw/fodder supplied, please bring your own.

All blowers and electrical equipment must be PAT tested.

The judge's decision is final.

All breeds to be shown under their Society Rules. All animals are to be adequately trained on the halter to lead in a safe and responsible manner. The stewards will have authority to exclude any unsafe animals from the site.

Continental and Native judge to judge champion and reserve champion of each breed.

Inter breed judge to judge champion native and continental which will then go head to head for supreme champion.

Prize money for calves born in 2026 will be awarded 1st £15, 2nd £10 3rd £5, prize money may be reduced if less than three in a class. Prize money of £50 will be awarded for champion Native and Continental and supreme champion £150.

No child under the age of 14 is allowed to show cattle in the ring unless they are in the young handlers class

In case of doubt, dispute or protest, such protest must be given in writing to the show secretary before the close of the show. Any person making such a protest must at the same time deposit the sum of £50.00, which will be refunded on production of the evidence in support of the protest. Should the protest not be upheld the amount will be forfeited to the funds of the show. The decision of the representatives of the show committee (Chairman, Secretary plus one other member) in all cases is final.

The show committee hold the right to amalgamate breed classes to AOB if numbers are low.

All entry fees are non-refundable.

All calves brought to the show must be entered (even if for Junior Handling)

All exhibitors and their stockpersons who behave noisily or offensively to the officials or judges are liable to be disqualified and any award cancelled and could be excluded from exhibiting in future shows by the committee.
